



## World Class Norfolk River

**F**ish for four species of trout in the cool tailwaters of the North Fork River below Norfolk Dam. The state record Brook Trout, at 5 pounds, was caught here in 2002. Also site of former world record Brown Trout weighing over 30 pounds. A favorite of fly fishermen when wading or boating. Features 1.5 miles of catch and release water. Access areas include the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission Bill Ackerman Handicapped access as well as the mouth in Norfolk and the Corps of Engineers Access and campground at Norfolk Dam.

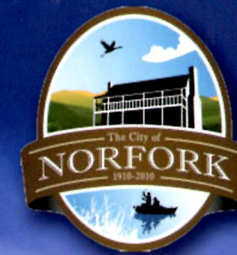
