Resolution for the Adoption of the Municipal Budget

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF A BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF NORFORK, ARKANSAS, FOR THE TWELVE (12) MONTHS BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2012 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2012, APPROPRIATING MONEY FOR EACH ITEM OF EXPENDITURE THEREIN PROVIDED FOR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Norfolk City Council has made a comprehensive study and review of the proposed budget submitted by the mayor, and;

WHEREAS, it is the finding and conclusion of the Norfolk City Council that the schedules and exhibits of anticipated revenues and expenditures for the calendar year appear to be as accurate as possible for budgetary purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE NORFORK CITY COUNCIL OF NORFORK, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. This resolution shall be known as the Budget Revision 1 Resolution for the City of Norfolk, Arkansas, for the twelve (12) month period beginning January 1, 2012 and ending December 31, 2012. The attached budget, incorporated herein as if set out word for word and figure for figure, reflects estimated revenues and expenditures as set forth on the succeeding pages.

Section 2. The respective funds for each item of expenditure proposed in the budget for 2012 are hereby approved and adopted for the operation of the City of Norfolk, Arkansas, by the Norfolk City Council on this date and constitute an appropriation of funds which are lawfully applicable to the items contained within the budget. This budget may be altered or revised by action of this governing body and unpledged funds may be subsequently appropriated to another purpose except as prohibited by law. A.C.A. § 14-58-203(a).

Section 3. The Mayor or his duly-authorized representative may approve for payment, out of funds appropriated by this budget or otherwise approved by the city council for those purposes, or may disapprove any bills, debts, or liabilities asserted as claims against the City of Norfolk. Provided, however, that the execution of all contracts and conveyances and lease contracts shall be performed by the mayor and city clerk or recorder, when authorized by a resolution in writing and approved by a majority vote of the city council present and participating.

Section 4. If any provision of this resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this resolution are declared to be severable.

A RESOLUTION authorizing the Council member, Nina Brewer to apply for a Trails for Life Parks and Tourism Grant on behalf of the City of Norfolk.

WHEREAS, the Norfolk City Council has determined that the City of Norfolk recognizes the need to provide public recreation facilities for its local citizens and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the City of Norfolk wishes to apply for Trails for Life grant funds through the Arkansas Department of Parks and Tourism to develop a Health and Fitness project at the following location: 49 City Hall Circle; and


WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Norfolk understands that if granted funds for park development, they must provide land, by lease or ownership, to develop the facilities on; and

WHEREAS, The City of Norfolk, Arkansas will sign a contract agreeing to provide the necessary resources to maintain this park and facilities for a period of 15 years;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of Norfolk, Arkansas hereby authorizes the Mayor/Council Member, Nina Brewer to submit and application for grant funding to the Arkansas Department of Parks and Tourism and to aid and assist Norfolk in executing the proposed project described herein and that the Mayor or Recorder/Treasurer is further authorized to administer the grant funds for the same project.


