**A Resolution setting the mill rate for the City of Norfolk to be used by the
Baxter County Quorum Court to levy taxes to be assessed in 2005 and
collected in 2006**

Whereas, the Baxter County Quorum Court is required by Arkansas Statute
Annotated 26-28-103 to levy all taxed at the regular meeting in November
of each year, and

Whereas, the City Council of Norfolk determines the mill rate to be used by the
County Quorum Court, and

Whereas, the City Council sets the mill rate for the General fund to be 5 mills
and the Street fund to be 1.9 mills for the taxes assessed in 2005 to be collected
in 2006.

RESOLUTION 2005-04**

A Resolution to grant permission to submit application to the Department of Arkansas Heritage for Determination of Eligibility for the old Norfolk School, Agricultural and Home Ec Buildings for nomination to the National Register of Historic places.

Whereas, the City of Norfolk is the current owner of the old Norfolk school buildings, and

Whereas, the City Council of Norfolk is the governing body that has the authority over city owned property, and

Whereas, the Determination of Eligibility is the first step in the process of being nominated to the National Register.

Whereas, the application for Determination of Eligibility for nomination to the National Register of Historic sites requires permission of the property owner, and

Whereas, the buildings were constructed of native stone in 1936-38 under the New Deal programs, the Work Project Administration and the National Youth Administration, and

Whereas, it was the Norfolk community educational facility for about 47 years, from 1938 through about 1985, and

Whereas, it would be valuable to the community to determine if the buildings do have historical value that would make preservation worthwhile, and

Now therefore be it resolved by the City council of the City of Norfolk, Arkansas, permission is granted to submit the application for Determination of Eligibility by approval of this resolution be adopted this 15th day of November, 2005.
