Be it hereby resolved by the City Council of the City of Norfolk, Arkansas, a resolution authorizing the Mayor of the City of Norfolk to proceed with street maintenance for the upper part of Third Street which is not normally maintained/repared by the city.

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Norfolk recognizes that the location of private residences at the top of the street has increased the use of the upper portion of Third Street, and

Whereas, the increased usage and weather is causing damage to city maintained streets with gravel from of the upper part of Third Street coming down onto the newly resurface city maintained streets, and

Whereas, the city sees the need to protect the city investment in the city maintained streets below, and

Whereas, the funds are available in the 2006 City of Norfolk's Street Budget, and

Whereas, RBC has made a proposal to complete the above street maintenance for a cost not to exceed \$ 6,320.00, and

Whereas, Mike Harrison, private citizen/resident at the top of Third Street has agreed to pay half of the cost, and

Therefore, be it resolved the City council of the City of Norfolk, Arkansas, hereby appropriates the sum of \$ 3,160.00, the city portion, for this project and that agreement to hard surface this section of road does not change the previous status of this street as a non city maintained street.

Be it resolved by the City Council of Norfolk, State of Arkansas a resolution entitled Community Center Grant Application.

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor of the City of Norfolk, Baxter County to apply for a grant on behalf of the Norfolk Community.

Whereas, the Norfolk City council has determined that the Norfolk Community meets eligibility requirements necessary to apply for a grant under the Arkansas Rural Community Grant Programs; and

Whereas, the Norfolk community has presented plans to generally refresh the Norfolk Community Center by overlaying the existing floor tile with plywood and vinyl floor covering; paint and update.

Whereas, the City council of Norfolk recognizes the need for the project, concurs its importance, and supports the City of Norfolk in its efforts to proceed with the same; and

Therefore, be it resolved that the City Council of Norfolk hereby appropriates the sum of \$ 183.50 to complete the local match money and 150 hours of Labor at \$17.19/hr for a total of \$ 2,578.50 in kind requirement for the project described herein;

Be it further resolved, that the City Council of Norfolk, hereby authorized to submit an application of formal request to the Arkansas Rural Development Commission for purposes of securing state grant funds in the amount of \$ 2,762.00 to aid and assist the Norfolk Community in executing the proposed project described herein and that the Mayor of Norfolk is further authorized to administer the grant funds for the same project.

Be it hereby resolved by the City Council of the City of Norfolk, Arkansas, a resolution authorizing the Mayor of the City of Norfolk to utilize the Capital Improvement funds to pay off the existing water system capital improvement debt.

Whereas, the City of Norfolk currently has three loans with the USDA and one loan with AR Soil & Water; and

Whereas, balance of those loans as of August 1, 2006 is as follows:

USDA #3 Sewer Loan	\$ 18,329.19
USDA #4 Booster Loan	\$ 32,106.52
USDA #5 Booster Loan	\$ 17,658.74
WSSW 77-06D	<u>\$ 20,902.52</u>
Total	\$ 88,996.97, and

Whereas, the funds from these loans were used to make capital improvements to the water system; and

Whereas, the intent and purpose of revenue generated from the 1% sales tax is to make capital improvements to the water system; and

Whereas, this revenue is held in the Capital Improvement fund with a July 31, 2006 balance of \$ 99,362.17; and

Whereas, City council of Norfolk feels it would be in the best interest of the city to use those funds to pay off this debt; and

Therefore, be it resolved the City council of the City of Norfolk, Arkansas, hereby appropriates the sum of approximately \$ 88,996.97 from the Capital Improvement fund to eliminate the water system debt shown above.
